Haeundae Beach and Haeridan Street

It is a representative attraction in Busan and the most popular beach in Korea, with about 1.5 km long sand beach and 1 m deep shallow water, making it perfect for swimming. There are many cafés and famous restaurants that have been renovated from old houses, as well as many other stores on Haeridan Street near Haeundae Station.

Haeundae Blueline Park

It is a scenic railway along a 4.8 km long stretch from Haeundae's Mipo to Cheongsapo to Songjeong. You can enjoy the spectacular coastal scenery through the windows on the train. In addition to the Haeundae Beach Train, the park operates the Haeundae Sky Capsule, which runs on an elevated railway 7-10 m above the ground.

OSIRIA is a large-scale tourist complex located on the east side of Haeundae. The complex has a theme park, activity facilities, a shopping mall, a luxury resort, and more. Lotte World Adventure Busan has many thrilling attractions, including a roller coaster that runs at up to 105 km/h and a water coaster that rapidly descends from 44.6 m height at 100 km/h into a pool of water.

It is the first place in Korea to see the sunrise each day. New Year's Sunrise Festival is held here every year, and many people make wishes as they watch the sunrise over the ocean. Moreover, it has one of the most breathtaking views on the East Coast, with the sea in front and the white lighthouse on the green grass field behind, creating a picturesque scene.

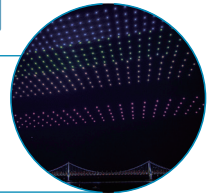

It is a village located on a steep cliff neighboring the ocean in Yeongdo. You can enjoy ocean views beyond the wall. Every alley in the village has pretty cafés and workshops. There are many photo spots, including the colorful rainbow stairs, Huinnyeoul Coastal Tunnel, which can be used as a frame for photos with the sea in the background, and Isongdo Observatory, where you can take photos like drama posters.

Dadaepo Beach

Dadaepo Beach, where the Nakdonggang River meets the South Sea, has soft white sand made during the long weathering period. It is perfect for viewing the sunset that turns the ocean to gold. Nearby are an ecological trail, where you can take a walk while enjoying the scenery of the wetlands and reed beds, and the Morundae Trail, with dense pine forests and coastal scenery.

Tip Every year, from April to October, the Dadaepo Sunset Fountain of Dream is held every night at Dadaepo Beach Square. 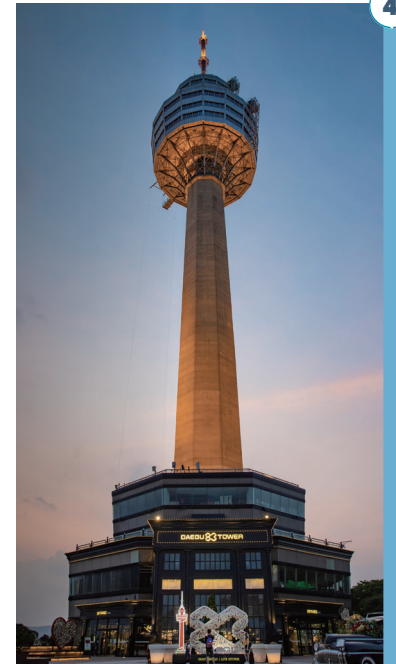
E-World and 83 Tower

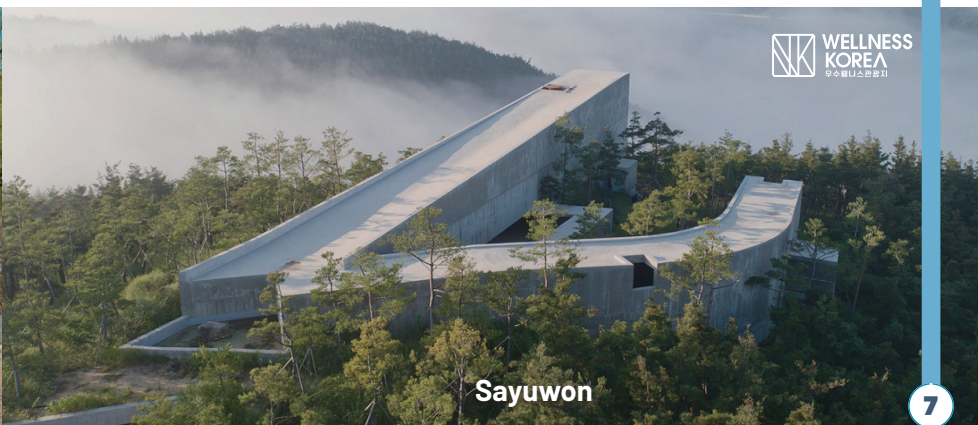
Hwabon Station

Tip Andong also has a unique and interesting local food called "heotjesabap" (meaning fake ceremonial food). It originated from poor Confucian scholars during the Joseon Dynasty who held fake ancestral rites when they wanted to eat a lot of food. It consists of vegetable bibimbap, grilled meat, and some pancakes.

Andong Soju & Traditional Food Museum

It was established to promote the history and cultural characteristics of Andong Soju and traditional Korean food. The origin and manufacturing process of Andong Soju are displayed using mannequins to make it easier to understand, and imitations of various traditional Korean dishes and Andong local dishes are also on display. Brewery and tasting rooms allow you to taste and smell Andong soju for yourself.

Andong Hahoe Village & Buyongdae Observatory

The village has been home to descendants of the Pungsan Ryu clan, a noble clan of the Joseon Dynasty, for over 600 years. It is registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its well-preserved traditional culture, especially the Confucianism culture of the early Joseon Dynasty's noblemen. Various traditional culture programs are available in this village, such as writing a family motto in Korean, having a traditional wedding, playing traditional games, and staying in a *hanok* (traditional Korean house).

You can also visit a restaurant selling traditional Korean food and an antique *hanok* café.

Hahoe Byeolsingut Tallori (Mask Dance Drama of Hahoe)

It is Korea's oldest mask dance drama performance, with 800 years of tradition. It is a work full of sharp satire about the hypocrisy of the ruling class, noblemen and scholars, and the social contradiction. It was inscribed as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity in 2022. The performance is held at the theater in Hahoe Village on Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays (only on weekends from January to February).
