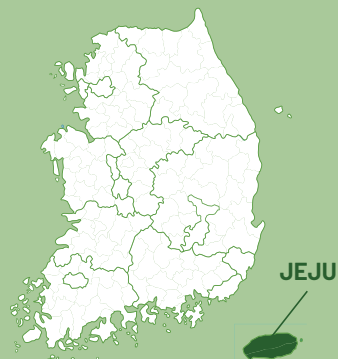


Jeju-do

Jeju Island



Jeju Island is the largest island in Korea, located in the southern part of the country. The entire island is made up of such diverse volcanic terrain that it can be called a “volcano museum.” It has been registered as a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site, Biosphere Reserve, and Global Geopark, achieving the “UNESCO Triple Crown,” which is unprecedented recognition.

You can relax in beautiful scenery, including Hallasan Mountain in the middle of the island, many *oreum* (parasitic cone) formed around it, the emerald sea, and the mysterious natural forest. Indoor experiences at museums, exhibition halls, and theme parks are also available.

Tip There is a night market every evening near entrance 8. You can taste delicious food cooked with Jeju specialties, such as black pork skewers, abalone gimbap, and hallabong juice.

Dongmun Traditional Market

Located near Jeju International Airport, it is the largest and oldest traditional market on Jeju Island. Here, you can find a variety of products, including Jeju specialties like tangerines, hallabong, cutlassfish, and diverse souvenirs. They also sell many delicious foods, such as tteokbokki, syrup-filled pancakes, and mandu.

Tip In addition to racing, the park provides various activities to enjoy, such as sky swing, metaverse experience, and laser survival game.

9.81 Park

It is a theme park where you can enjoy eco-friendly racing powered only by the acceleration of gravity (9.81 m/s²). You can enjoy speed and thrills beyond your imagination by going down the hill at speeds of up to 60 km/h while overlooking the Jeju Sea. There are four different types of tracks according to difficulty levels, and their racing scores and rankings are recorded, which is very challenging.

Tip At the midpoint of the trail, a transparent kayak rental is available. You can explore the Jeju Sea in a kayak that allows you to see clearly underwater.

Handam Coastal Trail

It is a walking trail along the shore from Aewol Port to Gwakjigwamul Beach. You can take a walk along the black basalt and blue sea while listening to the sound of the waves. In spring, yellow mustard flowers around the trail add to the pleasure of walking. There is Aewol Café Street nearby.

WE Hotel

It is the first medical tourism-themed health resort in the forest of Hallasan Mountain. It offers hydro programs that make use of the area's volcanic bedrock water rich in minerals and other wellness programs, including forest therapy, which helps you relax by walking along the forest trail around the hotel.

Pacific Mariner Yacht Tour (ex-Shangri-La)

It is a garden designed under the theme of "Peanuts," the comic strip featuring Snoopy. Snoopy Garden House, the indoor garden, has five themed halls, which give sympathy and consolation to visitors through the episodes in the "Peanuts," as well as Peanuts Store and Snoopy Café. In the outdoor garden, you can have fun finding Snoopy and his friends in the beautiful garden and taking pictures with them.

Seopjikoji

It is a coastal hill protruding toward the sea on the east side of Jeju Island. It boasts a spectacular view of strange rocks and the blue sea, and you can see Seongsan Ilchulbong Tuff Cone across the sea. In spring, yellow mustard flowers are in full bloom on the hills, creating a beautiful sight. In addition, there is a resort, an aquarium, and an ocean-view restaurant.
