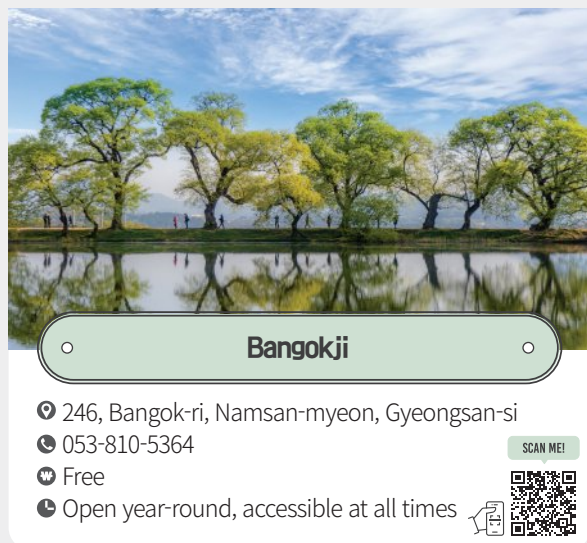

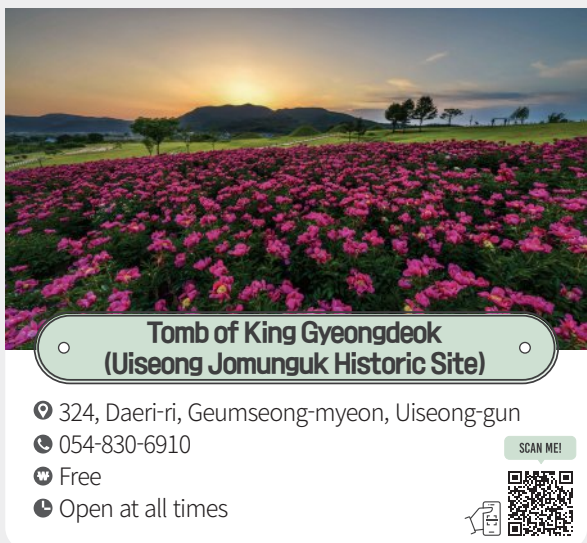

Seokguram Grotto is a representative cave temple showcasing the pinnacle of Silla Buddhist art and science.

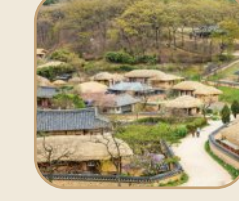

07 Andong Byeonseowon Confucian Academy

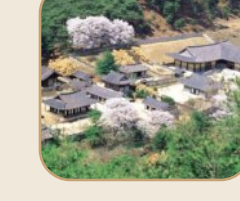

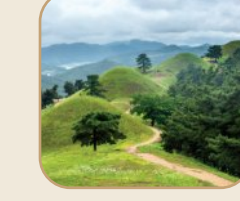

Embark on a culinary journey across Gyeongbuk with 10 regional signature dishes.

01 Pohang Gwamegil(Half-dried Fish)

Gwamegil is made by drying herring or saury in cold winds, resulting in a delightfully chewy texture. Mulhoe, a cold raw fish soup with spicy and tangy broth, is another must-try local delicacy.

02 Gimcheon Jirye Black Pork Barbecue

Black pigs raised in Jirye, Gimcheon are known for their tender texture and rich flavor. Charcoal-grilled, they offer a clean yet deep taste.

03 Mungyeong Yakdol Pork & Yakdol Korean Beef

Yakdol pork and beef are raised on mineral-rich stone feed, giving them a tender texture and rich umami. Omija(five-flavor berries) is another representative health food of Mungyeong.

04 Andong Andong Jjimdak(Soy-Braised Chicken)

Andong Jjimdak is a signature braised chicken dish cooked with soy sauce, glass noodles, and potatoes. Andong salted mackerel and Heotjesatbap(ritual-style rice dish) are also beloved local specialties.

05 Yecheon Sundae(Korean Blood Sausage)

Yecheon's sundae is a traditional dish made by stuffing pig intestines with a variety of ingredients. It boasts a unique flavor harmonized with local specialties.

06 Yeongyang Wild Vegetable Dishes

Known for its mountain herbs, Yeongyang offers a variety of dishes using wild vegetables. The fresh, aromatic flavors can be fully enjoyed here.

07 Yeongdeok Snow Crab Dishes

Snow crabs caught in clean waters are plump and sweet. They can be enjoyed steamed, in stews, and more.

08 Cheongsong Gochujang Chicken Bulgogi

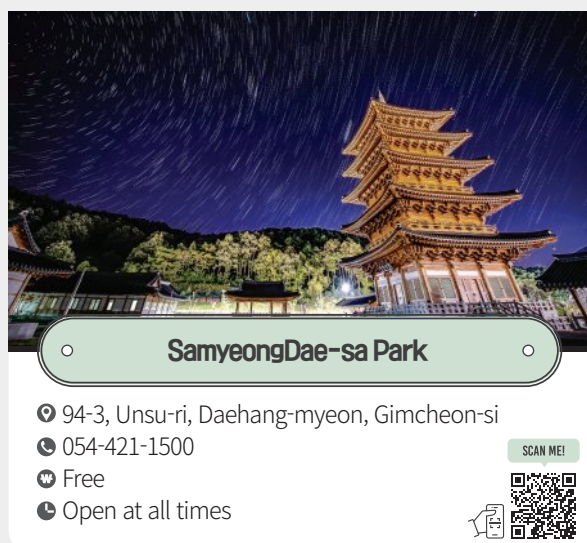
Cheongsong's gochujang chicken bulgogi is marinated in spicy red chili paste and grilled. The sweet and spicy flavors blend perfectly with the chicken's savory richness.

09 Yeongju Sunheung Mukbap(Acorn Jelly Rice Soup)

Originating from Sunheung in Yeongju, mukbap is a traditional summer dish made with acorn jelly and rice served in a chilled broth. It is known for its clean and mild flavor.

10 Cheongdo Persimmon Wine

Cheongdo, known for its persimmons, produces persimmon wine with a rich fruity aroma and a sweet yet clean finish. It is popular as a dessert wine.

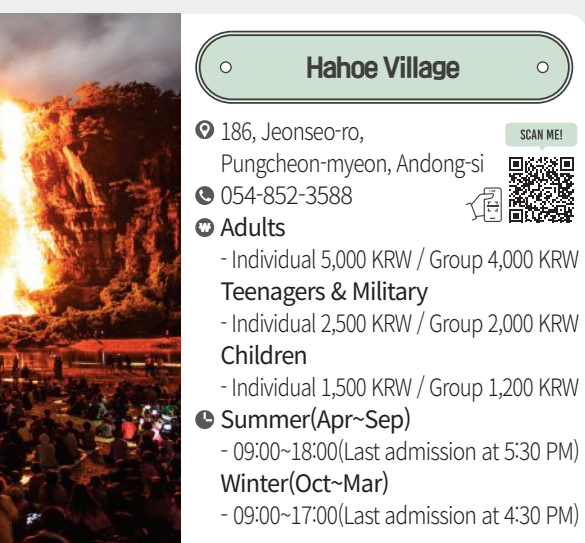
