NAMDONG-GU
Incheon Grand Park

This is Incheon's main green space. Ideal for walking and biking all year round. A walk along the tree-lined paths connects to various attractions, including a deer eco park, rose garden, children's zoo, and botanical garden. BUPYEONG-GU
Buypyeong Modoo Mall (Buypyeong Underground Shopping Arcade)

Buypyeong Modoo Mall is listed in the Guinness Book of World Records for the "World's Largest Number of Stores in a Single Area." MICHUHO-GU
Munhaksan Mountain

It's a small mountain, standing just 217 m above sea level, but it provides a panoramic view of downtown Incheon from the summit. Historical sites, like Munhaksanseong Fortress and a beacon tower from the Three States period, remain throughout the mountain, allowing visitors to find traces of history with every step. ☎ Munhak-dong, Michuhol-gu

Baedari Secondhand Bookstore Street

The smell of books drifts subtly under old signs between alleyways. Inside secondhand bookstores, a variety of books—from old print editions to antique volumes and fairy tales—are displayed, creating a unique atmosphere tied to a long history with books. ☎ 18-10 Gaupyeong-ro, Dong-gu

WOLMI SEA TRAIN

Wolmi Sea Train is South Korea's longest urban monorail, introduced to Wolmido Island. It travels 6.1 km around Wolmido Island in about 42 minutes. Running along a track at the height of a three-story building, it offers stunning views of Incheon Inner Port, the West Sea, and Incheon Bridge, along with the beautiful landscapes of Wolmido Island. It's especially popular for its breathtaking sunset views over the West Sea.

Discovering 168 Treasures

Sindo-Sido-Modo Islands

Just a 10-minute boat ride from Sammok Quay in Yeongjong International City, and connected by bridges, Sindo-Sido-Modo Islands are unique destinations that you can explore all at once. Enjoy biking or driving along the sea breeze.

Deokjeokdo Island

Deokjeokdo, the main island of the Ongjin Sea, is a diverse travel spot offering hiking, swimming, fishing, and even camping. The wide beaches and green forest trails create a unique experience, as if feeling a different season on the island.

Gureopdo Island

Gureopdo, a small island in the West Sea, is a favorite spot for backpackers, featuring untouched nature. Spending a night among the endless grasslands, sea, and unique rock formations provides a genuine island experience, enhanced by starlight and the sound of waves.

Daejakdo Island

When you stand on the top of Busan Mountain, the wide blue sea and islands spread out before you like a painting. "Pulgyung," a mysterious tidal sand island that only appears at low tide, is the essence of Daejakdo Island. As you walk, you'll discover yet another stunning seascape.

Incheon's islands scattered across the sea take on different faces. From simple islands along the coast to those in the deep seas at the end of the West Sea, 168 treasure-like islands await travelers.

Seungbongdo Island

Named for its shape resembling a phoenix spreading its wings, Seungbongdo Island is a gem of the West Sea, featuring beaches and unique rock formations. Walking along the winding coastal trail, you'll be surprised by a magical landscape shaped by wind and waves.

Yeonpyeongdo Island

Yeonpyeong Island, known for blue crabs, is a place where abundant fishing grounds and peaceful seascapes come together. As the site of the Battle of Yeonpyeong and the bombardment, it also serves as a reminder of the value of peace.

Baengnyeongdo Island

Baengnyeongdo Island, situated at the northernmost tip of the West Sea, is famous for Dumjiung, where rock formations create a stunning scene, and Sagwi Beach, which stretches straight out like a runway. It's a place where you can experience a unique sense of emotion and relaxation amid beautiful natural scenery.

Daecheongdo and Socheongdo Islands

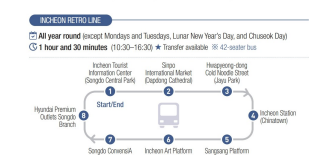
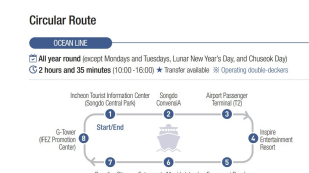

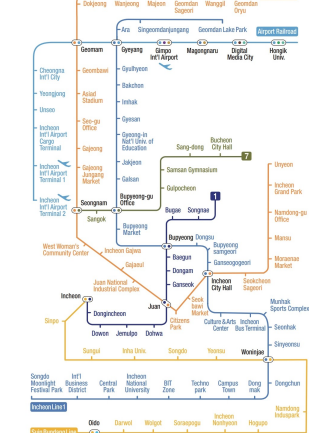

Travel Back to the Modern Times

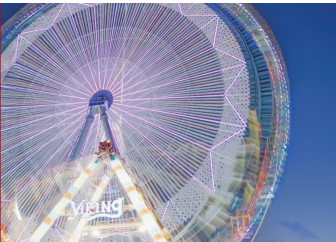

Daebul Hotel Exhibition / Jung-gu Life History Museum

Daebul Hotel Exhibition restores Daebul Hotel, Korea's first Western-style hotel built in Incheon in 1888. It highlights travelers' hotel experiences and architectural styles from the port-opening era. Jung-gu Life History Museum takes visitors through the modern and contemporary life history of the Jung-gu area.

Incheon Open Port Modern Architecture Museum

It is an exhibition hall that showcases the structures and features of modern buildings built during the port-opening period. Using actual construction materials, miniatures, touch-screen content, and more, visitors can easily and enjoyably explore the architectural history of the open port area.

Jaya Park

It is Korea's first Western-style modern park. Built on a hill that was once a foreign settlement during the port-opening period, it offers a panoramic view of Incheon Port and the surrounding streets. With the statue of General MacArthur and the Korea-U.S.A. Centennial Monument, visitors can explore both its history and natural scenery.

Incheon Citizen Love House

It was originally a Japanese-style house built in 1913, later turned into the residence of the Incheon Mayor, a historical museum, and finally a cultural space for citizens in 2021. It hosts book talks, exhibitions, and educational programs, while also preserving remnants of foreign settlements from the port-opening period and offering a view of Incheon Port.

Noodle Platform

It's a detailed exhibition space centered on noodles like jajangmyeon (black bean noodles), naengmyeon (cold noodles), and jjimjmyeon (spicy chewy noodles). It provides an opportunity to explore the culinary culture and history of Incheon's noodle industry during the port-opening era. The area features unique cultural zones that combine displays, interactive activities, and photo spots.

UNIQUE POINTS

Incheon Open Port Culture Night

A special walk unfolds under the night sky along the streets of the open port area, where traces of modern history remain intact. The architectural and cultural heritage of Incheon, which has been nurtured since the opening of its port, shines beautifully at night. Night scenes, cultural heritage exhibitions, performances, and night markets are also held.

DoImens in Bugeun-ri, Ganghwa

It is a table-shaped dolmen built during the Bronze Age B.C. Beneath its capstone, which measures 7m in length and weighs approximately 80t, remain the remains of prehistoric rituals and lifestyles.

Ganghwa History Museum

This exhibition space offers an overview of Ganghwa's history and culture by era, from prehistoric times to the late Joseon Dynasty. Digital videos help visitors experience the significance of Ganghwa Island in history more vividly and three-dimensionally.

UNIQUE POINTS

Gyodongdo Island, Where Time Stays

Gyodongdo Island may seem somewhat desolate because it is accessible only through the Civilian Control Line, but like other islands in Incheon, it is peaceful and tranquil. A significant portion of Gyodongdo Island's residents are from Yeonbaek-gun, North Korea. Refugees fleeing the Korean War made their home on this island. Perhaps because of this, traces of time seem to have stood still throughout the island.

A Day to Immerse in Scenery, Seokmoldo Island

Seokmoldo Island has a harmonious blend of mountains and sea and is easily accessible by car via Ganghwa Island. With open-air hot springs, a recreational forest, and a beach all in one place, and beautiful sunsets to enjoy, Seokmoldo Island attracts many seeking healing.

Jeongseojin

It's a ferry dock at the westernmost tip of the Korean Peninsula when viewed from Gwanghwamun Gate, and it's one of Incheon's most popular sunrise spots. The sun sets over the sea, blending with the Sunset Bell to create a stunning scene.

National Institute of Biological Resources

This institute conducts research on national biological resources with the largest facility of its kind in the East. Visitors can experience the actual environment in the recreated rivers, lakes, tidal flats, and marine ecosystems. The extensive outdoor green space includes well-maintained walking trails.

Ara Tower, Gyeongjin Ara Waterway Passenger Terminal

From the 23rd-floor observatory, visitors can enjoy a clear view of the West Sea, Gyeongjin Ara Waterway, and Cheongna district. In Aram, the promotion center on the first floor, visitors can explore the history, ecology, and cultural stories of Gyeongjin Ara Waterway.

Aramaru

It is a circular observatory built on the Gyeongjin Ara Waterway. A panoramic scenery unfolds along the waterway before your eyes, and the floor lighting gently illuminates the area at night to create a unique atmosphere.

Gyeongjin Araon

It is a waterfront cultural space located along the Gyeongjin section of the Gyeongjin Ara Waterway. Walking trails, a waterside stage, and a bicycle path come together around the traditional garden called Suhyangwon.

Suhyangwon

With a majestic hippos-and-gable roof pavilion and upright pine trees, Suhyangwon perfectly captures the beauty of a traditional Korean garden. It exudes a tranquil atmosphere and the grace of a classical scholar.

Yeongjong Seaside Rail Bike

You can enjoy a rail bike with a sea view, and various amenities are also available, including tent and caravan camping sites, as well as a water park in the summer. Unique seascapes of the sea off Incheon unfold as you ride along the track.

Eurwangjin Beach

Eurwangjin Beach boasts stunning scenery, featuring a crescent-shaped sandy shore and lush pine forests that resemble a traditional Korean folding screen. It is Incheon's top beach and a designated national tourist spot. The tidal flats that emerge at low tide and the soft sandy beach create a scenic view.

Inspire Entertainment Resort

It is a relatively newly built, large-scale integrated resort that offers a variety of facilities, including a hotel, a glass-domed water park, an outdoor park, a shopping mall, and a casino. Notably, a dedicated performance arena is well-known for K-pop concerts and performances by international artists.

Paradise City

It is an integrated resort with a hotel, swimming pool, spa, club, shopping arcade, casino, and theme park. Guests can enjoy culture and leisure, making it a unique retreat. Art Paradise is a museum-themed hotel showcasing contemporary art in its rooms and public areas, providing an art experience.

UNIQUE POINTS

Geojampo Beach

Located along the route between Yeongjongdo and Muuido Islands, this port is the perfect spot to enjoy both sunrise and sunset, which is rare on the West Sea since it faces east. The uninhabited island called Madoangdo, offshore, is known as "Shark Island" because of its shape that resembles a shark's fin.

Murengoti

The name, created by combining the "M" in "Muuido" and the African word "Serengeti," refers to the expansive natural grasslands that extend along the coast of Muuido Island. Its distinctive Serengeti-like landscape earned the name "Murengoti," and it has become a popular spot for backpackers and campers.
