Hallasan National Park

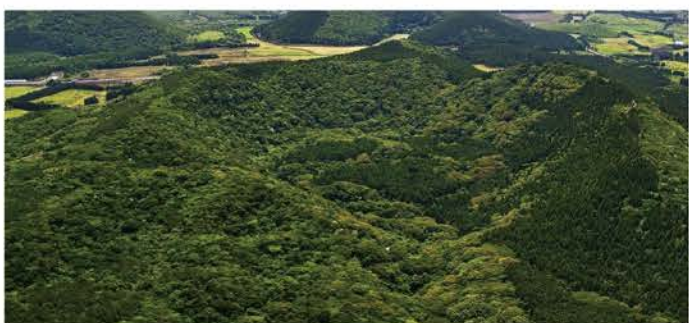

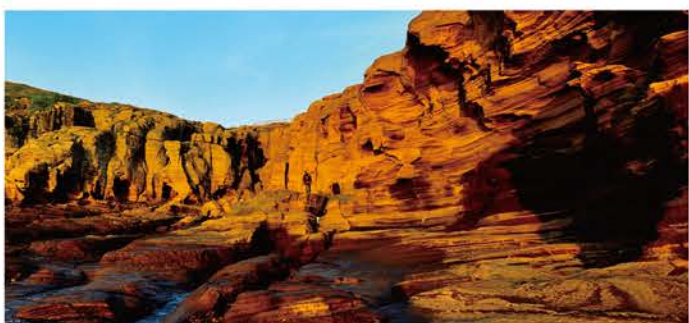
F Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak)

This tuff cone formed when an underwater volcano erupted in the middle of the ocean. It was designated as a national monument due to its high preservation value. It was registered as a UNESCO World Natural Heritage Site in 2007 and UNESCO Global Geopark Site in 2010.



G Geomun Oureum

Geomun Oureum is the only oureum on Jeju Island that is a UNESCO World Natural Heritage. The volcanic terrain and lava caves have extremely high geological value.



H Yongmeori Coast

Yongmeori is a sandstone beach created by layers of sand that have been deposited for tens of millions of years. The mysterious scenery of the coast is enough to make anyone who witnesses it exclaim in wonder.
